**T**he Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) Clinic is a program of the National Autism Center and May Institute. The ASD Clinic is located in Randolph, Mass., and provides diagnostic evaluations and therapeutic treatment services to children and adolescents with ASD and their families. Our experienced clinicians offer services that include standardized assessments, behavioral treatment, social skills development, and parent support.

## **We provide:**

- Diagnostic assessment services for individuals ages 18 months to 21 years to evaluate ASD and other developmental disabilities
- Assessments by child psychologists who use standardized measures, including the Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule (ADOS), to evaluate developmental, cognitive, and behavioral functioning
- A comprehensive written report and the opportunity to work with clinic staff to implement treatment recommendations at home and school
- Therapeutic and support services to help families adjust to an ASD diagnosis and manage stress

The Center is open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

We accept most insurance — commercial, private, Medicare, Medicaid, and MBHP.
